

Process to be Added to DAHP Consultant's List

To be listed as a consultant with the Department of Archeology and Historic Preservation, persons should meet the various professional qualifications as set forth by the Department of the Interior, National Park Service (Federal Register, Vol. 62, No. 119).

Applicant's must submit a resume that outlines their related experience in historic preservation activities, proof of educational background (in the form of transcripts or copy of diploma) and or proof of appropriate state license. In addition, examples of projects should be submitted in the form of a brief portfolio.

This information is kept on files at DAHP and should be updated periodically. Please send the required information to the Department of Archaeology & Historic Preservation (PO Box 48343, Olympia, WA 98504-8343). It will be reviewed by our State Architect, or the Deputy State Historic Preservation Officer. If you meet the criteria, you or your firm will be added to our consultants list and posted on our web site.
