Apartment To Be Shown In Maple Valley

Fairwood Apartments, the latest addition to the Fairwood golf-course community in Maple Valley near Renton, will be open to the public today for the first time.

A furnished apartment will be open, and the first of a series of one-bedroom apartments will be available for renting. Two bedroom apartments will be ready September 15, in the first group of 176 apartments.

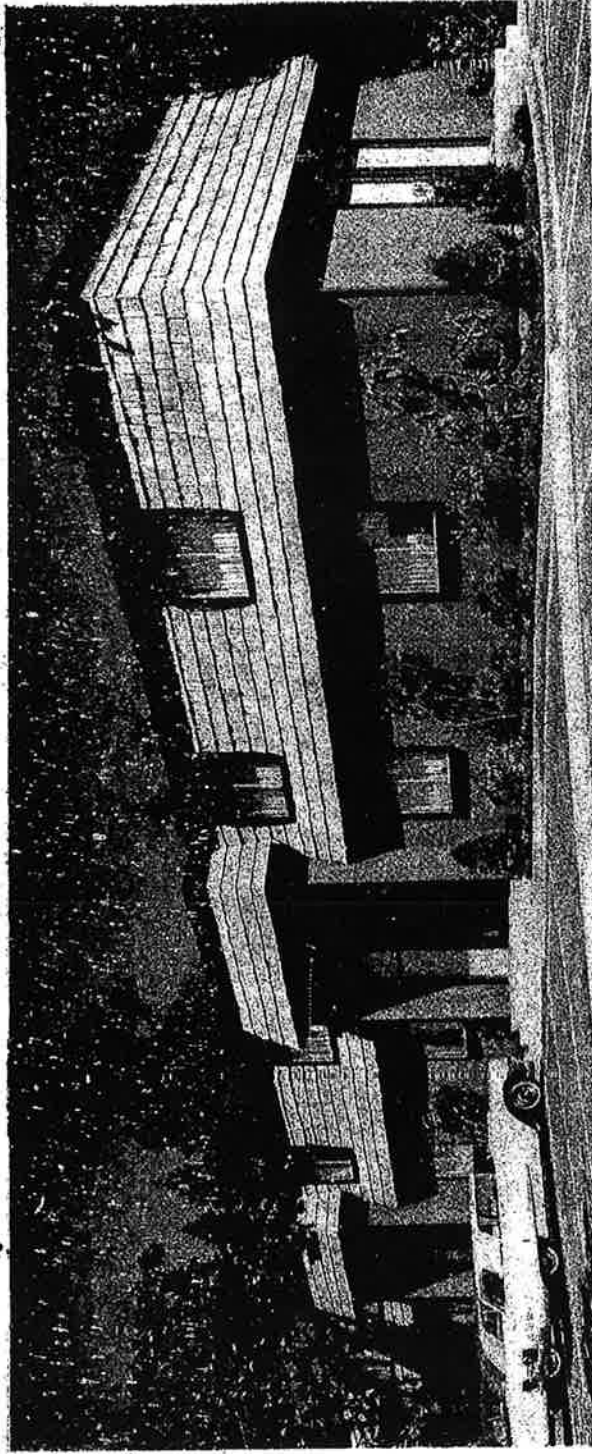
THE \$1.5 MILLION APARTMENT development will include 780 units in 7½ buildings. Recreation facilities, including a swimming pool, adult-recreation and exercise areas, saunas, game and billiard rooms, party and social rooms and children's play area, will be in the center of the grouping of apartment buildings.

Fairwood Apartments is a joint venture of Crossroads Properties and the multifamily division of the United Homes Corp.

The buildings are of shake and cedar with mansard roofs. Henry Griffin of the United Homes Corp. designed the structures.

RENTALS WILL START AT \$110 for one-bedroom apartments and at \$150 for the two-bedroom units. Each has carpeting, draperies and fully equipped kitchens.

Some nonresident memberships in the Fairwood Golf and Country Club will be available to tenants, the developers said.

The \$1.5 million development will have one- and two-bedroom units and full recreation facilities, including a swimming pool. Crossroads Properties and the United Homes Corp. are cooperating in the project.
