Site and survey locations are based upon field verification and reported to DAHP. Base maps are of varying scales and quality. DAHP examines and records these sites onto 7.5 minute USGS quadrangles. These sites are then digitized into the GIS (Archaeology sites are buffered based on the site type. In the case where more than one site type applies, then the greatest buffer distance was selected and applied to the data.) All attribute data are stored in the associated Access 2000 databases (ArchaeologyData_HARN_GDB.mdb, Register.mdb, for National and/or State Register listed sites and surveyreports_GDB.mdb for Cultural Resource Surveys) and related to the GIS layer based on the SITE_ID (Smithsonian Trinomial) for Archaeology and National and State Register listed sites or NADB for survey reports.
