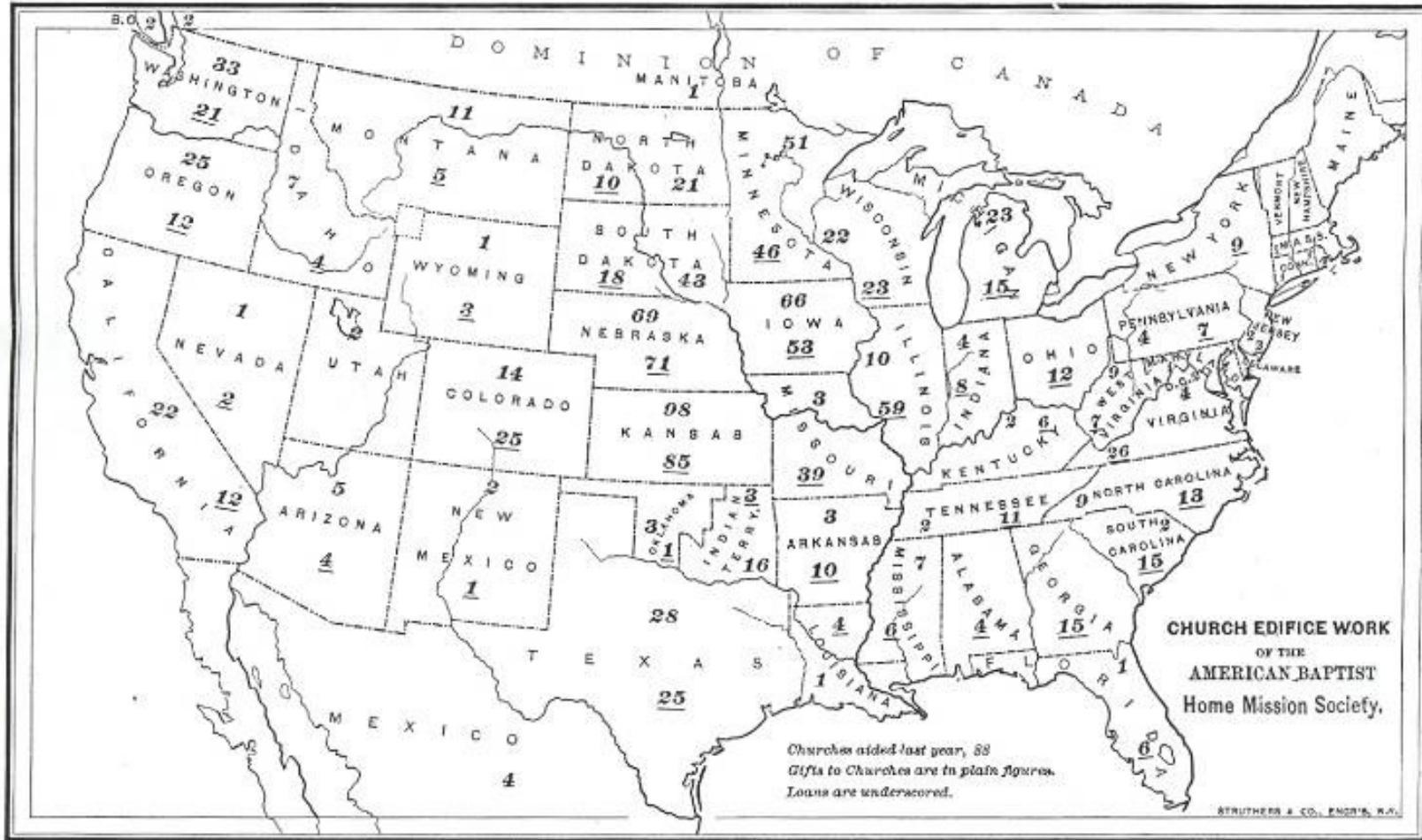

Financial Assistance Map from the Baptist Missionary Society - 1892



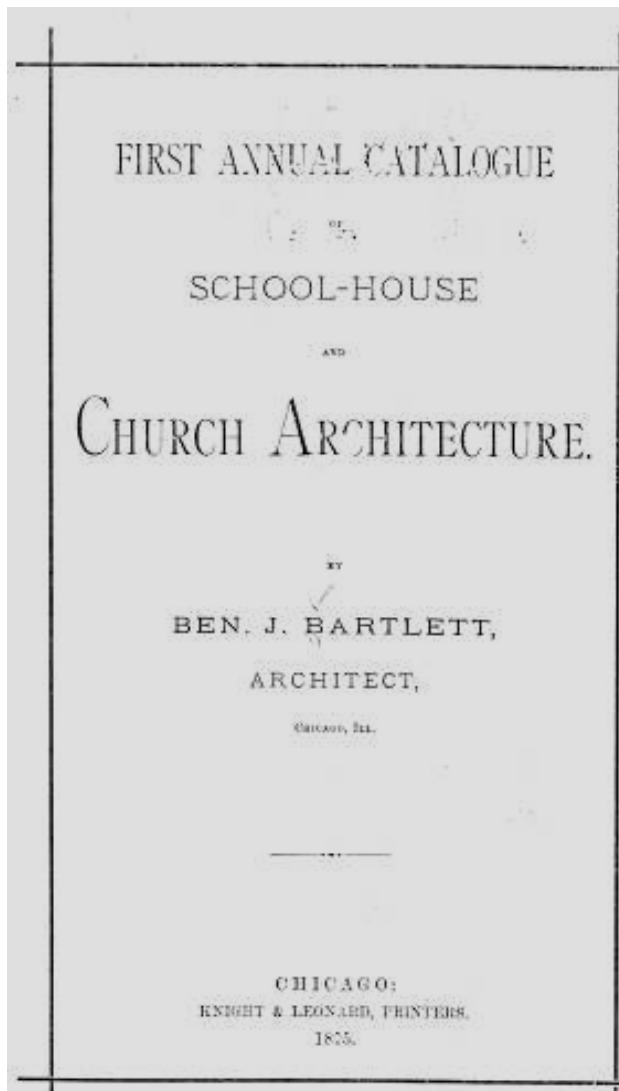

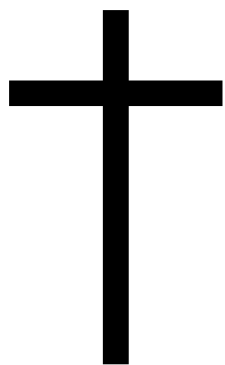


Typical Crucifix Plan

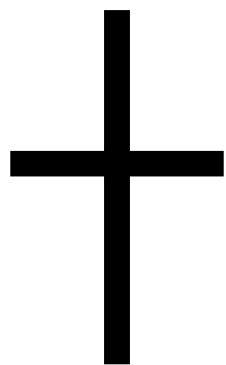

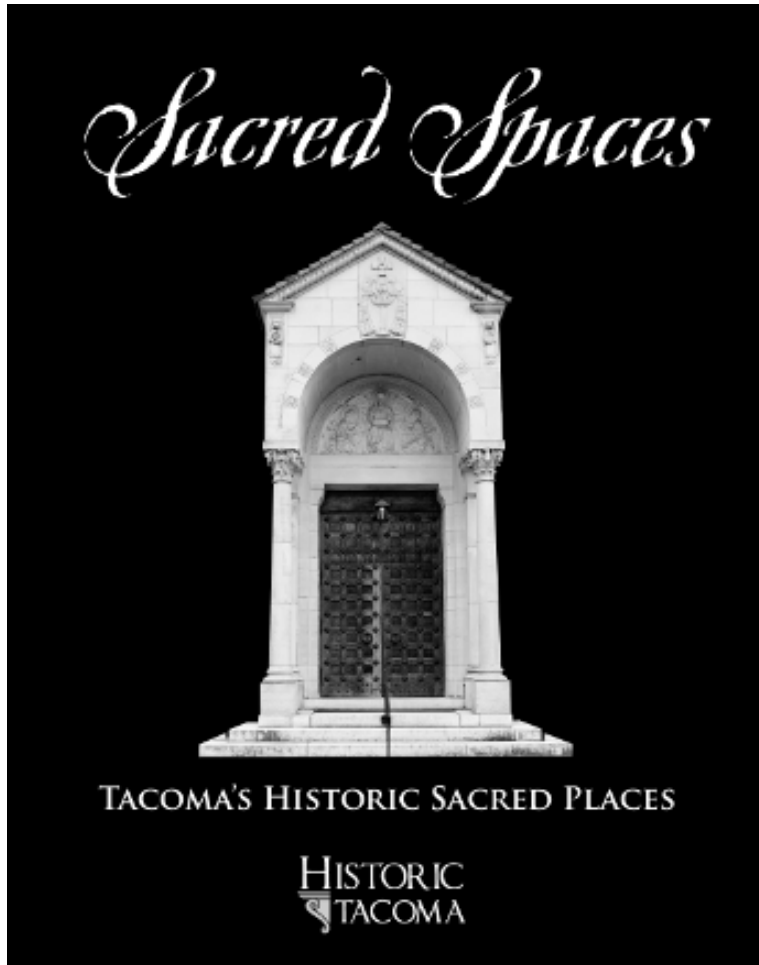
