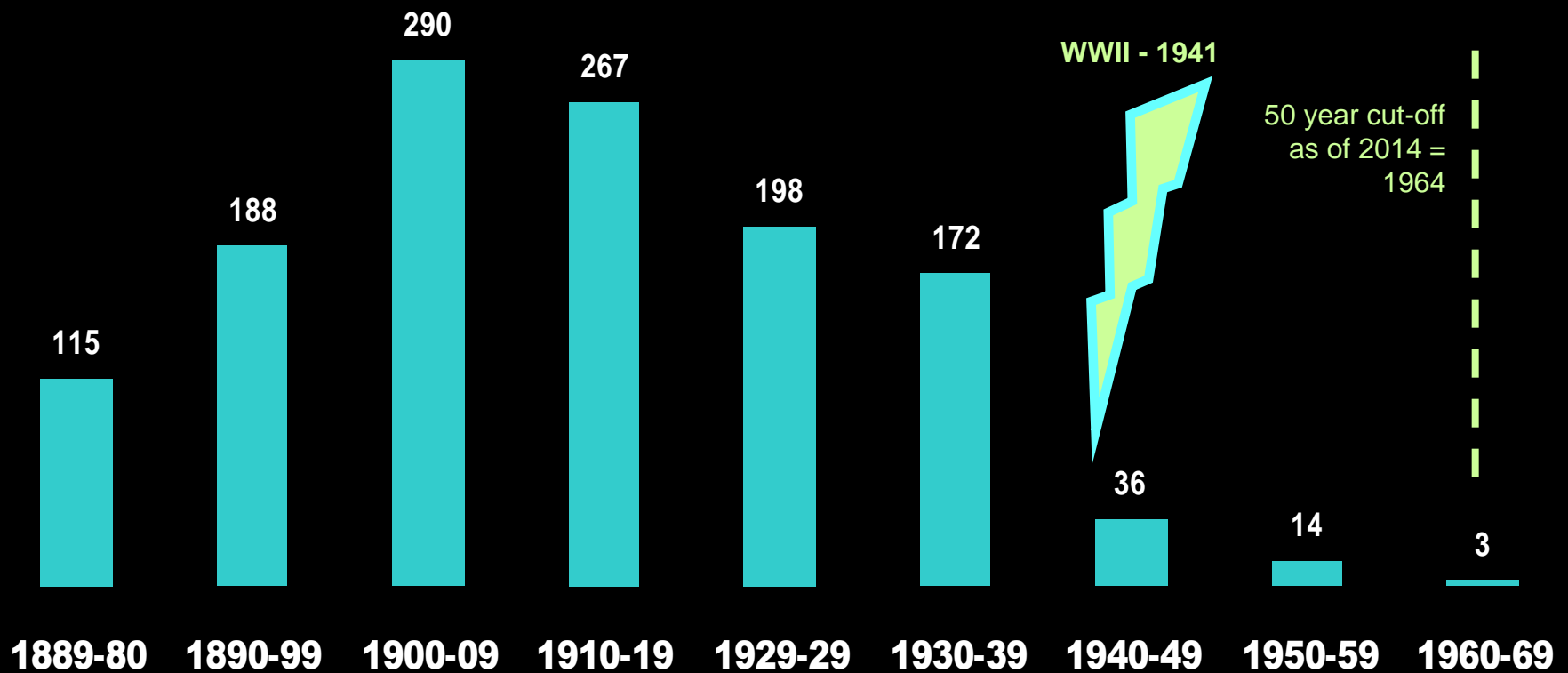


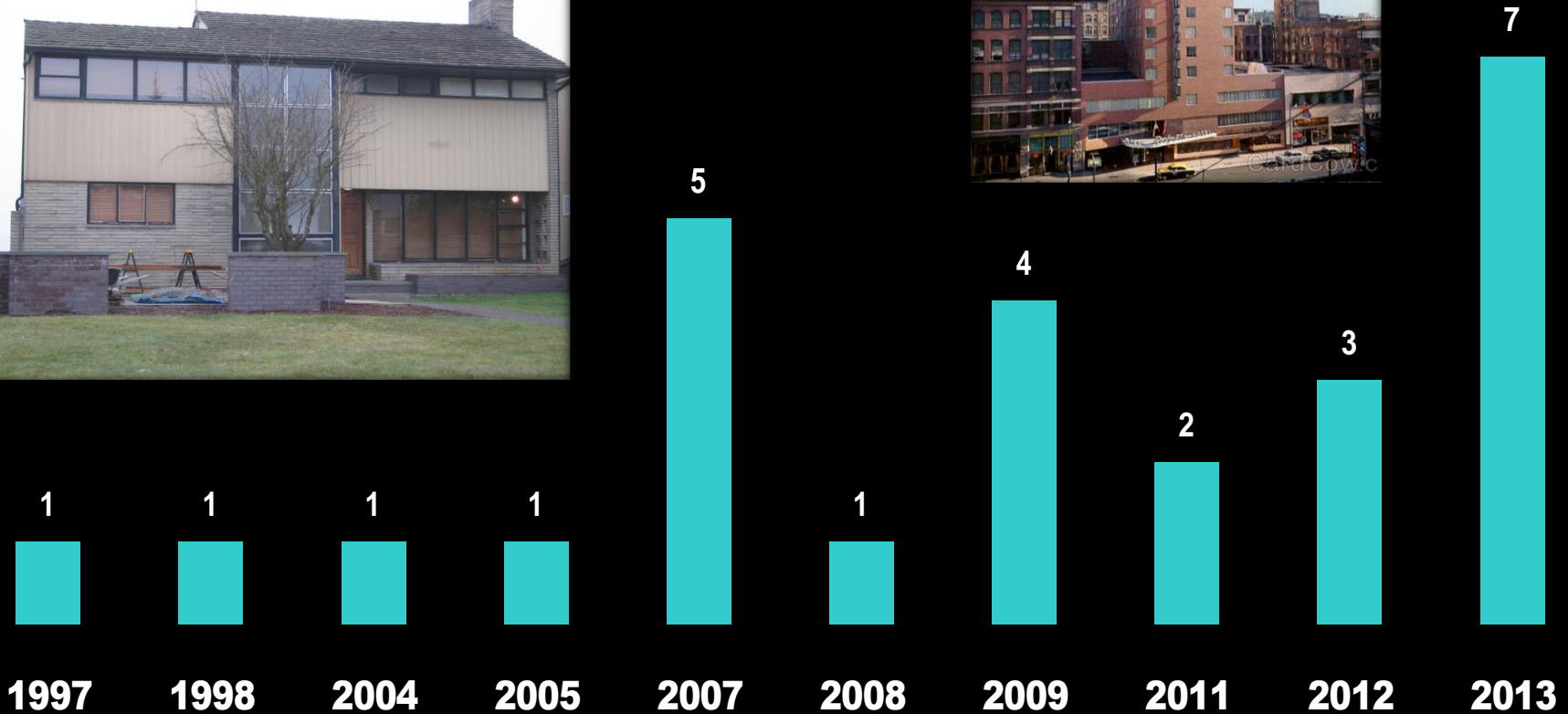
National Register Nominations By Built Date

Trend: Drastically decreasing number of post WWII listing. Shows the need to focus on listing post WWII resources before they are lost.



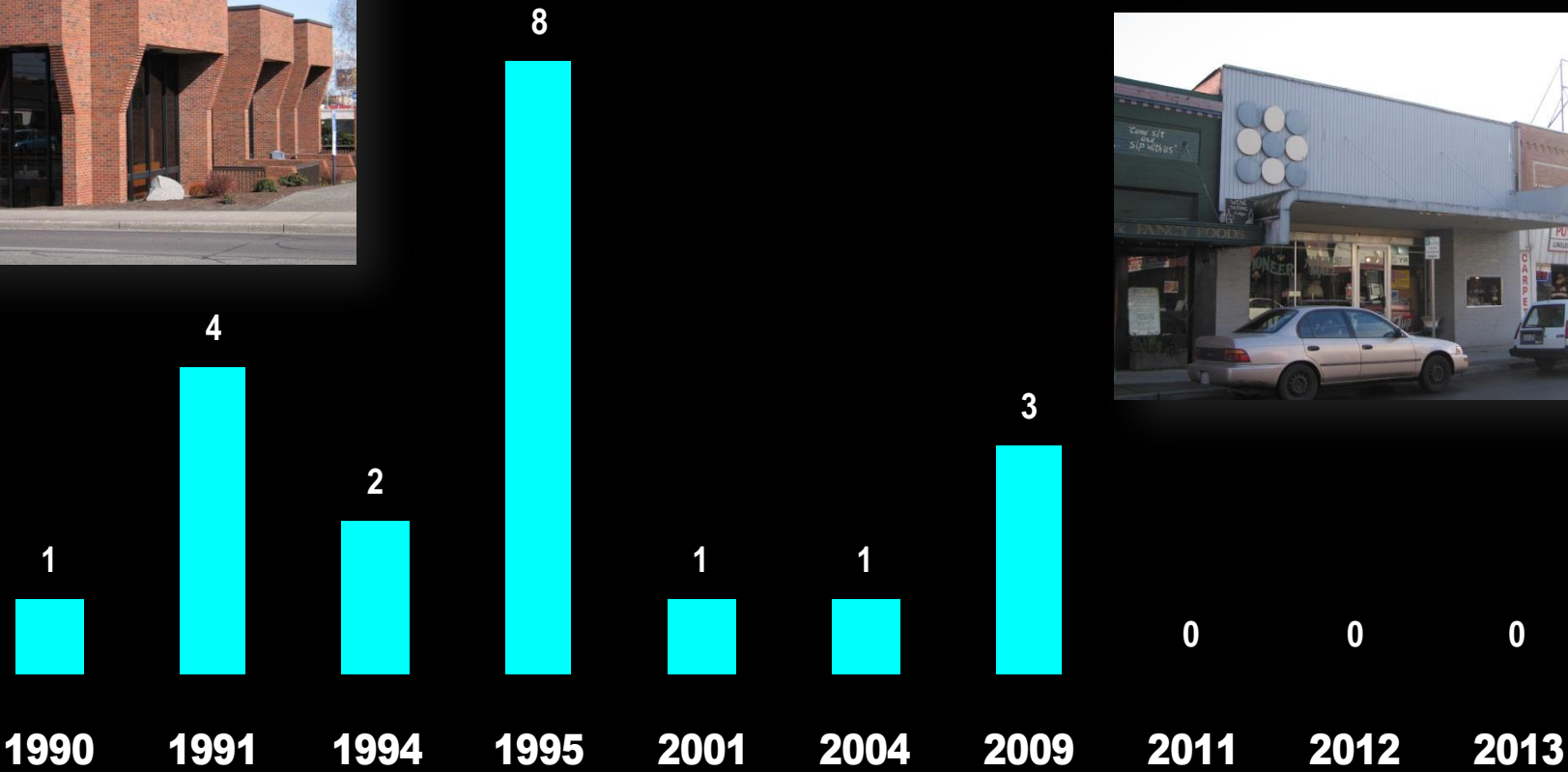
National Register Nominations of Post WWII Listings

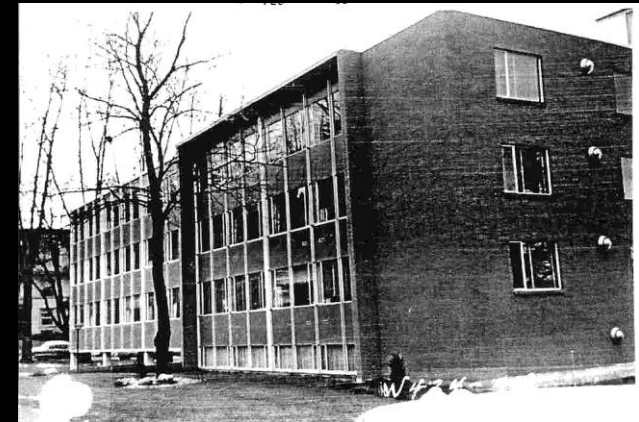

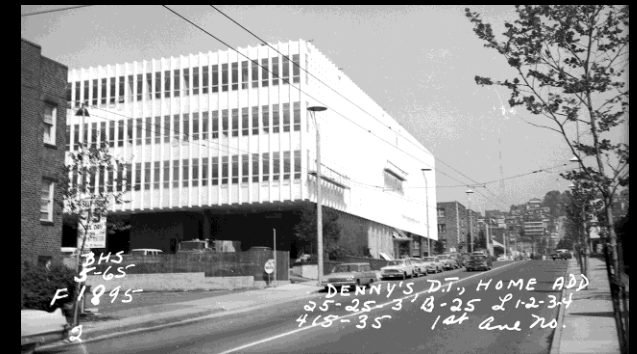
