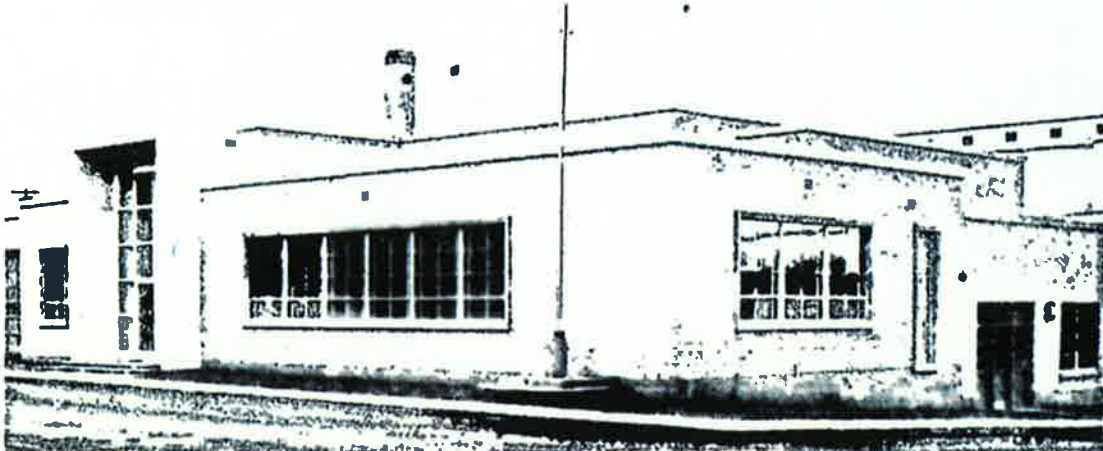


*Cheney Dedicates New \$163,000 City Light Building at Civic Fete*



Cheney's \$163,000 combined city hall and city light department building was dedicated at a civic celebration last night. The building, designed by Benjamin K. Ruehl, Spokane architect, houses under one roof all the facilities of the Cheney municipal light department, police department, fire department

and a small but modern city jail. Roy L. Bair & Co., Spokane contractor, erected the building. An auditorium and kitchen are included on the second floor. Mayor Lloyd G. Holloway was master of ceremonies at the dedication. The new building replaces Cheney's first city hall built in 1890.
