


COUNTY COURTHOUSE PROJECTS BENEFITING FROM THE COURTHOUSE GRANT PROGRAM

A statewide survey conducted in 2003 determined 33 of the state's 39 county courthouses to be of architectural and historic merit. These courthouses have over \$90 million of need in capital improvements. In response to this need, the Legislature established the Historic County Courthouse Rehabilitation Grant program in 2005. Since the program's inception, 80 applications have been submitted requesting over \$32.5 million. Fifty-three grants have been awarded to 25 counties statewide.



Photos 1-3, Spokane County

Stabilization of iconic clock tower, ADA accessibility improvements, rehabilitation of interior spaces, and general restoration of key character-defining elements. Received 4 grants: 07-09, 09-11, 11-13, 13-15. Total of 4 Grant Awards: \$2,313,688. Total Project Costs: \$4,627,377.

Photos 4-6, Garfield County

Comprehensive rehabilitation of the 1901 courthouse. Received 1 grant in the 09-11 biennium for \$1,000,000 (utilized \$988,023). Total Project: \$1,976,046.



Photos 7-9, Jefferson County

Stabilization of the clock tower and roof, window rehabilitation, and restoration of key character-defining features. Received 3 grants: 05-07, 09-11, 13-15. Total of 3 Grant Awards: \$1,350,000. Total Project Cost: \$3,993,183.




Photos 10 - 12, Douglas County
Rehabilitation of key character-defining elements, including front entry and rehab of the cupola and widow's walk.

Received 3 grants: 05-07, 09-11, 13-15. Total of 3 Grant Awards: \$48,918. Total Project Costs: \$72,813.



Photos 13-15, Mason County

Comprehensive exterior rehabilitation, ADA improvements, and interior rehabilitation of key character-defining elements. Received 2 grants: 07-09, 11-13. Total of 2 Grant Awards: \$1,050,000. Total Project Costs: \$2,246,397.



Photos 16-17, Snohomish County

Roof replacement and structural stabilization of clock tower, along with exterior rehab. Received 2 grants: 05-07, 07-09. Total of 2 Grant Awards: \$222,670. Total Project Costs: \$862,588.



Photos 18-20, Stevens County

Improving ADA accessibility, roof replacement, window rehabilitation, and rehabilitation of key character-defining elements, including the fountain and front entry. Received 3 grants: 05-07, 07-09, 11-13. Total of 3 Grant Awards: \$320,303. Total Project Costs: \$649,774.
