

RESERVE MANAGER FOR EBEY'S LANDING NATIONAL HISTORICAL RESERVE

Ebey's Reserve is a 17,572-acre National Register District with more than 400 contributing structures, three State Parks, a significant archaeological record, and the historic town of Coupeville. The Reserve's managing partners are the National Park Service, Washington State Parks, Island County, and the Town of Coupeville.

Key responsibilities include:

- Coordination of the Reserve's Intergovernmental partnership.
- Protecting, preserving, and interpreting the Reserve's significant resources.
- Monitoring and managing protective scenic easements.
- Supervising and administering the Reserve's Trust Board operations and staff.
- Providing support for historic preservation with tools such as rehabilitation grants, financial incentives and technical assistance, and supportive policy.
- Participation in the local preservation/design review process within the Reserve.
- Conducting outreach and education to strengthen public support for the Reserve and its resources.

The successful candidate will:

- Be adept at working with complex social networks, relationships, and pressures.
- Inspire community engagement and passion for the Reserve,
- its heritage and resource value.
- Display flexibility and patience with bureaucracy, budget, and work plans.
- Possess skills in collaborative work with private and governmental agencies.
- Enjoy working closely with the Trust Board in a spirit of teamwork.
