Tasks involved include developing new goals, objectives, and strategies for historic preservationists to achieve during the 2019-2014 planning cycle. - 9:30 SEPA & FPA Overview

Local Government Archaeologist Stephanie Jolivette and GIS Cultural Resource Analyst Morgan McLemore will take some time to go over DAHP review and processing of proposals authorized or permitted by local and state agencies under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) and Forest Practices Act (FPA). Stephanie and Morgan will explain their submittal requirements, workflow, and tips to make for an efficient review process.

Morgan will be on hand to provide an update on future changes to DAHP's WISAARD system. After that discussion, she will also do a "walk-through" of the Archaeological Site Inventory form as a refresher for how to complete the form and upload into WISAARD. Morgan is allowing plenty of time for questions.

DAHP's National Register Programs Coordinator Michael Houser will be on hand to share information about the agency's Mick and Nick Show technical assistance program. During these on-site visits, Michael joins with Historic Architect Nicholas Vann to help owners address specific questions on managing their historic properties.
