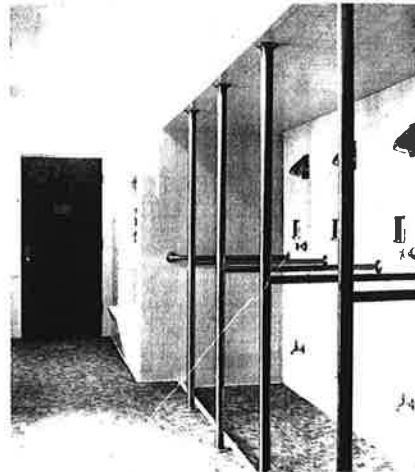


typical floor plan

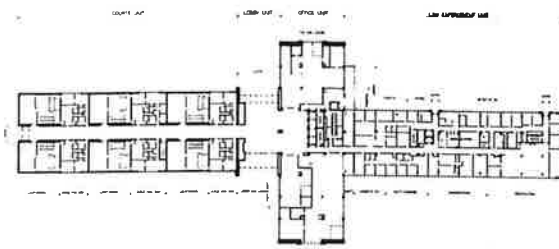

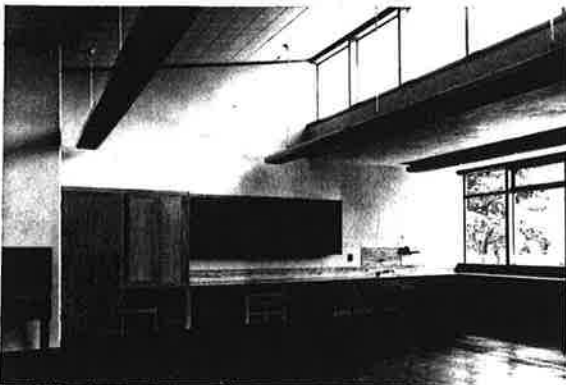

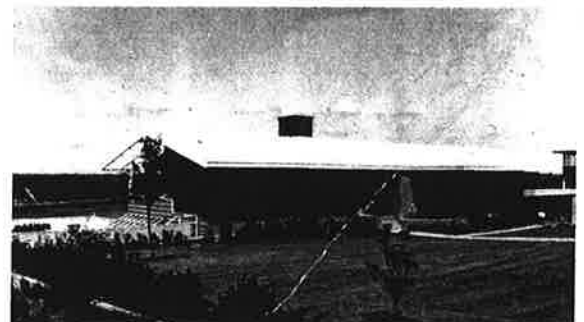

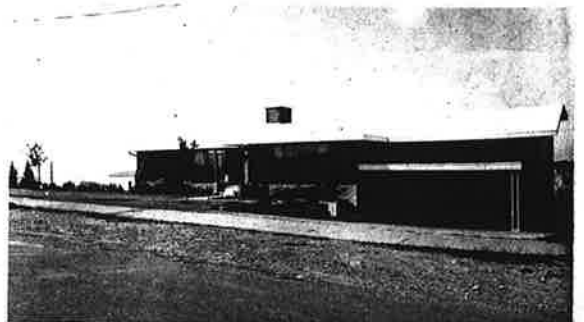
