Commemorate the historic and architectural significance of the **Research Technology Laboratory (RTL)** hosted by The Department of Energy's Pacific Northwest Site Office and the Pacific Northwest National Laboratory (PNNL).

The RTL building and associated support buildings were demolished in the spring of 2018 in order to remediate radiological contamination within the buildings.

Presentations from the Department of Energy, PNNL, the National Park Service, City of Richland, and the comments from the Washington State Department of Archaeology and Historic Preservation will highlight the history and historic significance of the RTL building, the role of the building in the region's economic diversification program, and the context of the RTL in relation to Hanford.
