



The Stella Historical Society started as a tax-free organization in 1976. A blacksmith shop, built in 1907, was donated to the Society in 1984 and placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1989. A post office building was also donated and moved to its present location at the Society's museum complex, located at 8530 Ocean Beach Highway, Longview, WA 98632.

Kids' Day at the Museum opens the museum season the first Saturday after the 4th of July with old-time games and treats at old-time prices. Tour the museum and participate in the scavenger hunt all during the season, Saturday and Sunday 11am to 4pm until Labor Day. The museum is also available by appointment by calling 360-423-3860.

Remnants of the Past festivities are held from 10am to 4pm on the first Saturday after Labor Day. Activities include a blacksmith demonstrating craft skills at the museum. At Stella Lutheran Chapel find a farmer's market and bake sale, old photo display, vendors, and lunch available.
