Forward

N placing the "Practical Plan Book" on the market I have aimed to give to those interested in home building, the most practical and convenient arrangement of rooms, together with artistic and well proportioned exteriors, adapted to the cooler climates of the North and East.

This book differs from most of the so-called "Bungalow Books" now in circulation, in that none of the designs are subject to the handicap prevailing in the California types, which make no provision for basements, heating plants, and other necessary utilities without which a Northern home is a complete failure.

The designing of an artistic and practical Bungalow or residence of any kind requires much skill and education, together with practical knowledge of building construction. When I started to fit myself for the Architectural profession I firmly believed that a man had no moral right to call himself an Architect until he was thoroughly familiar with all kinds of building construction. Otherwise he is not in a position to know whether his client is getting the kind of work that the Specifications call for. Most any draughtsman with a technical education can make a nice looking picture on paper, but it is doubtful whether it will be practical enough for the builder to work from. Many a home builder has been put to needless expense and much inconvenience from trying to build from such plans.

Before taking up the study of drawing I spent several years with the best and most experienced builders I could find, and learned thoroughly the mechanical end of building construction. After becoming an expert in that line I took up the study of drawing and design, and now with twenty-five years experience on high-class work, I believe that I am in a position to give the very best service that money can buy.

As regards the estimated cost, it is not possible to make a price that would apply to any locality. The estimates given are as near as possible what the buildings cost to build in Seattle. The exact cost of a building must be governed by the cost of labor and material in the locality in which it is built.

My plans are practical working drawings, complete in every detail, accurately prepared, and ready for any good carpenter or builder to go ahead with the work. They cover foundation, floor, and roof plans, different elevations, details of interior finish, and fixtures, such as sideboards, book cases, kitchen cupboards, mantels, etc. Typewritten specifications to cover the carpentry, plumbing, plastering, electrical work, painting, tinting, brick work, etc.

Anyone purchasing a set of plans from me will find me always ready and willing to answer any inquiry or assist them in any way I can with my experience.

I wish to call attention to the fact that I do not limit myself to the sale of plans now in my stock, inasmuch as I am fully prepared to incorporate your ideas in special drawings. If you wish to order special drawings, I would ask that you send me all the data possible, giving the number and arrangement of rooms, and the amount you wish the house to cost, enclose \$5.00 for pencil sketch, which I will prepare and send to you for criticism and alterations; the finished drawings are not completed until these sketches are approved. In order that I can give you a correct estimate of the cost of your building it would be well to send me a schedule of the cost of labor and material in the locality in which you intend to build.
