

FOREWORD

Complete blueprints for any of the houses shown in this book are available from the publishers. Blue prints show four elevations, cross section, foundation or basement plan, floor plans, cornice and interior built-in details. Plans show all dimensions, the sizes of all doors and windows, framing lumber sizes and all other information necessary to the construction of a home; however, due to the wide variance in the kinds of materials used and in the construction methods employed in various sections of the country, no written specifications or plot plans are available.


Square foot areas shown are total ground covered area exclusive of garages and porches. Plans are complete and will meet Federal Housing Administration requirements with a few variations required by local conditions, when accompanied by a plot plan showing the size of the individual lot and the location of the house on it along with walks, driveways and any special sewer connection or disposal detail and by FHA form specifications which are obtainable from any FHA loaning institution.
