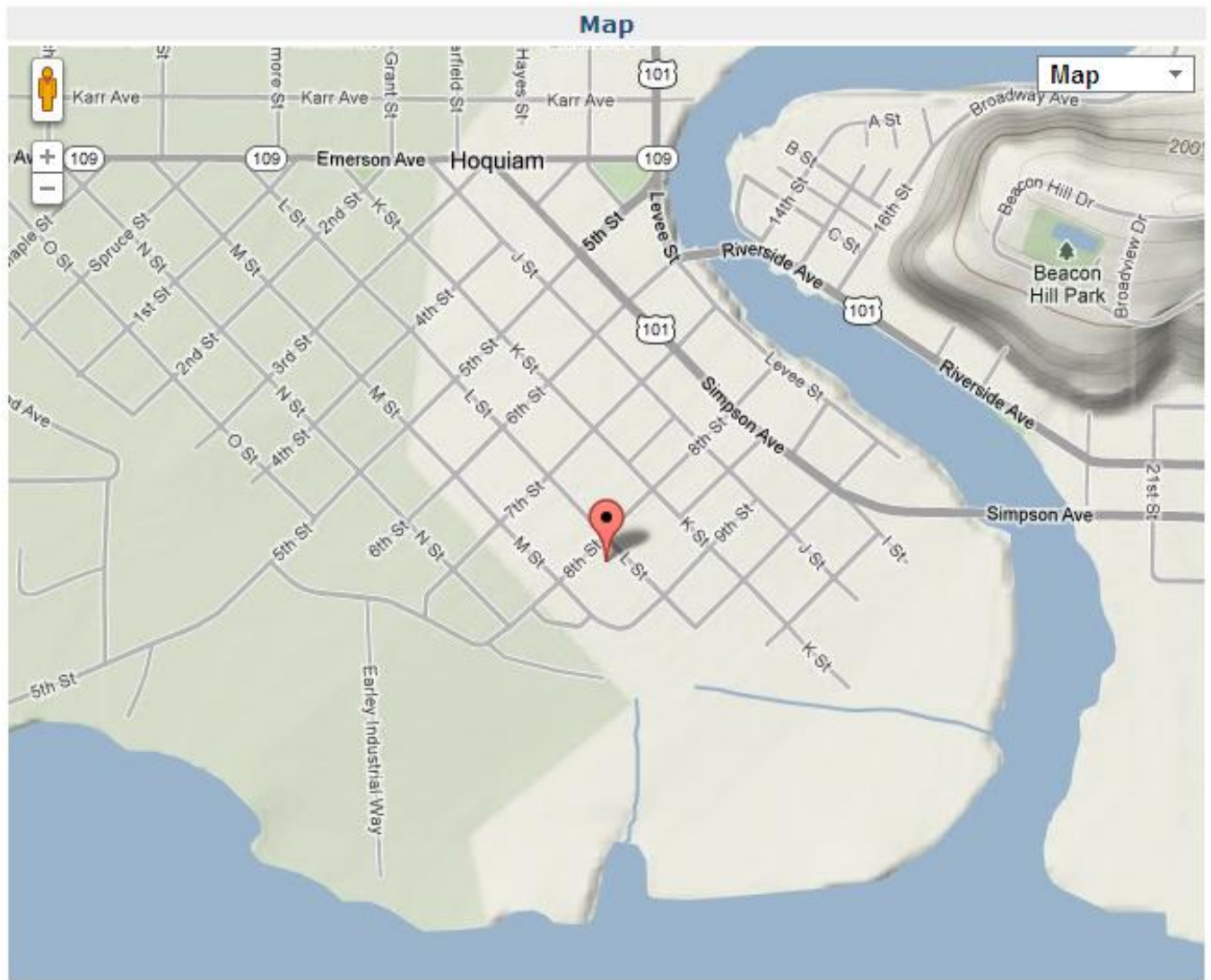

Directions:

- ❖ Traveling west on US 101 (Sumner Avenue) stay in the left lane. After crossing the Riverside Bridge take an immediate left on 6th street into downtown Hoquiam. Travel one block and take another left on Simpson Avenue. Travel two blocks and take a right on 8th Street. City Hall is three blocks away on the left side of the street.
- ❖ Traveling east on US 101 (Perry Street turns into Lincoln then into Simpson Avenue) or SR 109 (Emerson Avenue turns into Simpson Avenue): Stay on Simpson Avenue through downtown Hoquiam. Turn right on 8th Street. Travel three blocks and City Hall is on the right.



Parking:

There is on street parking available, in addition to a public parking lot across the street from City Hall.
